All media accepted, including prints (must label). Each of 3 categories is judged separately. No late entries will be accepted. All entries must adhere to our "Artwork Guidelines". Art sales agreement: 70% to artist, 30% to NPAC. Awards are presented at the Gallery Receptions. NO ADVANCE Notice to winners, please plan to attend the receptions which are open to the public. "People's Choice Award" is chosen at the receptions.

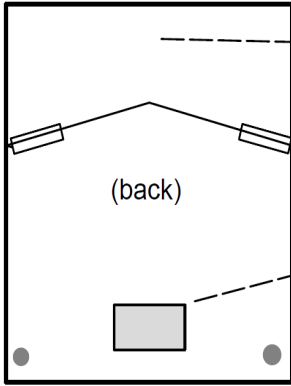
ENTRY FEE

NPAC Members -- \$10 per piece or 3 for \$25

Non-Members -- \$15 per piece. You may join and renew at the receivings.

ARTWORK GUIDELINES for NPAC GALLERY SHOWS

- Artists' choice of Categories of Awards: 2-D, 3-D and Photography. Submit up-to-3 art entries total per show.
- Professional-looking frames and mats, clean and unblemished. Gallery Committee or Judge will reject work that is unacceptable. Artists will be permitted the opportunity to fix a problem during the Receiving session. 2-D art and photography must be framed or gallery-wrapped.
- Professional presentations for 3-D artwork: Jewelry, sculpture, functional pottery, ceramics, wearable art, collage, *etc.* must be displayed on stands you provide or must be able to be wall-mounted or shelf-standing.
- Original art references, or credit photo, your Prints and Gicleés accepted. Indicate as such.
- No annual repeat submissions. Work must have been created in past 3 years. Glass allowed up to 16" x 20" frames, larger must be under plexi-glass. EXCEPTION: any size pastels/charcoal may be under glass.
- Artwork may be for sale. If not, list as "NFS" (not for sale). Sales Commission = Artist 70% and NPAC 30%.
- Please sign your artwork on the back – include title, medium, name and contact information.
- Diptychs and triptychs must be framed alike. Each piece pays a show fee.
- We do not accept nudes, offensive or violent subject matters.
- Ribbons and cash awards are presented at the show's gallery reception. Please attend or send a representative. Award winners will not be notified in advance.
- Art Show Schedule available at NPAC and on website **www.northportartcenter.com**.
- Adhere to all receiving, reception and removal dates and times! If you cannot attend, send a representative! We do NOT store artwork. Entries left at NPAC for more than 2 weeks will become a donation to NPAC!
- Artwork that does not adhere to the show theme will NOT be considered for awards by the Judge; but may be accepted for display and/or sale only.
- Hanging hardware:
 - No saw tooth hangers. Use picture wire attached on the back.
 - **Adhere to the diagram below.** If you have any questions, please call NPAC 423-6460.



Slight slack in wire, so there is at LEAST a 3-4" space, from peak of wire to the top of the frame.

Attach wire 1/4 to 1/3 down, from top of frame with D-rings, eye screws, etc. Optional: Slide on aquarium hose tubing or tape here, to secure wire ends and protect walls. A professional touch!

"Title", medium, name and contact information on back – OR – attach your business card that includes the same information.

Attach rubber bumpons, foam pads or felt tabs at both bottom corners. This protects walls and helps keep artwork level. A must at NPAC Gallery! These can be purchased at any hardware, craft or big box store.
